The volunteers figured out a way to make concentrate from the powder and a small amount of water, then mix the concentrate into the big cans. This worked much better than trying to mix the powder directly in the big cans. Most of last year's volunteers were there again, plus 3 new volunteers. The para-racers came just zipping by first, but didn't want drinks. The runners and walkers did, though.

Jordan has heard about a Neighborhood Watch thing that Pleasant View is doing, and he will investigate and bring more info to the next meeting.

Kathie couldn't remember the date for the September bus tour, but said it will be a Saturday with no Griz game. We should soon be receiving the invitation to the tour and a form to sign people up to attend.

- Establish goals for our Neighborhood Council - right now, all we have is the future prospect of Pleasant View Park development plus the Marathon and the annual Neighborhood Picnic in conjunction with the Pleasant View Neighborhood Yard Sale.

Kathie reported that we have our new budget from the City - \$800 in our general fund and \$553.88 in the mailing fund. We decided to postpone budgeting until after the fall meeting so we can see whether residents have issues that we need to address.

We're going to try to organize the rest of the stuff for the fall meeting via e-mail, so the next LT meeting wasn't set.
