

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity of Missoula (HfHM) has built 53 homes in Missoula since 1991 in order to provide affordable housing, all while empowering families to build their own homes through 500 required “sweat equity” hours; and

WHEREAS, HfHM has engaged over 2,500 individual and regular volunteers who have contributed over 182,000 volunteer hours in Missoula since 1991; and

WHEREAS, HfHM has provided stable, safe and healthy homes and shelter since 1991 to 145 Missoula children living in poverty housing; and

WHEREAS, HfHM’s partner family homes have contributed over \$1 million to the Missoula city and county property tax base; and

WHEREAS, HfHM is providing a long-term solution to the affordable housing crisis in Missoula.

NOW THEREFORE, I, John Engen, Mayor of the City of Missoula, in the State of Montana, hereby recognize the Wednesday before Thanksgiving as;
