Receive a reduction of parking account balance with food donations

The Missoula Parking Commission, in conjunction with the Missoula Food Bank, is running a food drive throughout the month of November. The Parking Commission will accept donations of non-perishable food items toward the payment of outstanding citations (not applicable toward boot fees). Each item donated will count for \$2 off the balance on the vehicle, up to \$10 (five items) off from Nov. 1 through Nov. 30.

Throughout the year, the Parking Commission gives financial support to many organizations in support of our mission to work with government, businesses and citizens to provide and manage parking and parking alternatives. With the hope of stretching beyond our mission and further giving to our community, again this year we are proud and excited to pair with the Missoula Food Bank in an effort to provide support for a hunger-free Missoula

- Canned soups (low sodium)
- Pasta
- Baby formula
- Baby food
- Whole-grain items
- Gluten-free items
- Low sodium/low sugar items
