-Birding area is looking great. Biehl's and Conner's are watering each week. A schedule was sent to the committee for watering sign up, no additional volunteers have come forward.

-Interpretive Sign Project and Trail work – Morgan Valliant sent an email stating that the interpretive signs project was put on hold. He is looking to hire a designer for all the parks involved with the project as there will be continuity and will be able to order all the signs together for better cost. Look for more news this late fall.

-Outdoor Classroom -John Conner has been working on sprucing up the grant for the Outdoor Classroom. He will add Nathan McLeod, City landscape architect, to work on the ADA and other recommendations when the Parks Board approves the project. Morgan feels that this will pass and Donna Gaukler is very supportive of the project. Parks Board Meeting is on Tuesday, September 8, 2020.

-Dogs off Leash - Dave Westfall said Morgan Valliant told him that people should call 911 for aggressive dogs off leash in the park. The 911 dispatcher will transfer your call to the animal control. Do not hesitate.
