2. Minutes from the September 7, 2022 were approved as posted.
3. Treasurers Report- Colleen Biehl reported on the current budget. See attached spreadsheet.
4. Sunday Streets September 18, 2022 Summary – Terry Conner reported that Sunday Streets was a huge success with hundreds of people enjoying the Fall weather. We gave away all of the free ice cream tokens from Big Dipper that we used some of our 2021-22 budget money along with many yard signs “Drive like your kids live here”. Meet lots of neighbors asking what they saw as needed in the neighborhood. Many talked about the traffic on Queen and other streets that are not involved in the new calming circles and stop sign arrangement. Drivers are moving other streets.
5. A Call for Street Art - James Walter reported that they held a vote for the calming circle artwork, it was a tie. 160 votes were tallied. A tie breaker will decide on the first artwork to be installed.
6. Traffic Safety Committee – Terry Connor mentioned the amount of neighbors that found the problem traffic had moved to other areas of the neighborhood. People are super concerned for the safety of pedestrians and kids on bikes. Ben Weiss attended the Sunday Streets and while he was near our table, we did voice concerns and talked about the crosswalk on Bancroft and Queen. Ben Weiss to be invited to our General Meeting
