The Missoula and Bitterroot Valleys are the original homelands of the Séliš (Salish) and Qlispé (Pend d'Oreille/Kalispel) people who inhabited this land since time immemorial. This area was also frequented by other tribes including the Ksanka (Kootenai), Niitsitapi (Blackfeet), Newe (Shoshone), Apsáalooke (Crow), and Ka'í gwu (Kiowa).
