Upcoming Events:

Neighborhood Picnic: The Pleasant View yard sale was last month, and it rained. No picnic. We will try for July, towards the end. Kathie will check with Donna about whether the City owns the park yet. If not, we need to check with 44 Ranch to see if they are interested in doing a picnic at their park.

Marathon: The marathon will be July 11th. We will staff the Kona Ranch aid station again. This year, the staffing times will be 5:30 to 8:30 am. We will team with a 4H club, as there will be twice as many runners as in the past. Nathan made volunteer request posters to hang around. Kathie will also send out an e-mail requesting volunteers.

Pleasant View Park: Kent was paid for the charrette work. Kathie hasn't heard anything since. She will find out how the design is progressing.

Mullan Road Bike Path: The path is partly paved (the stretches at intersections) and should be finished later this summer.

Budget: Kathie reported that there's only \$133.51 left this FY, so we did a good job of spending our money for the neighborhood. The mailing for the charrette cost \$649.98 (\$110 for the County print shop, \$442.08 for the mass mailing, and \$97.88 for the addresses that had to be individually addressed). Since the mailing supplement fund was only \$553.88, the rest came out of our general funds. The budget for next FY isn't finalized yet. Since the City has some budget issues, it's reasonable to assume that there may be some reductions to Neighborhood funds.

What project should our neighborhood tackle next? It was suggested that perhaps we could partner with adjacent Homeowner Associations to do improvements for the Mullan Bike Path – such as mutt mitts and garbage cans and/or benches. Randy will get a list of Homeowner Associations. Heather and Kathie will use that to search for officers and websites so we can get contacts established.

Kathie reported on the May community Forum meeting. Due to budget cuts, the Office of Neighborhoods lost the administrative assistant position. We need to check and maybe modify our bylaws to be sure they clearly define the roll of County residents in our Neighborhood Council, including the County Liaison on our Leadership Team.

The meeting adjourned about 8:40 pm.
