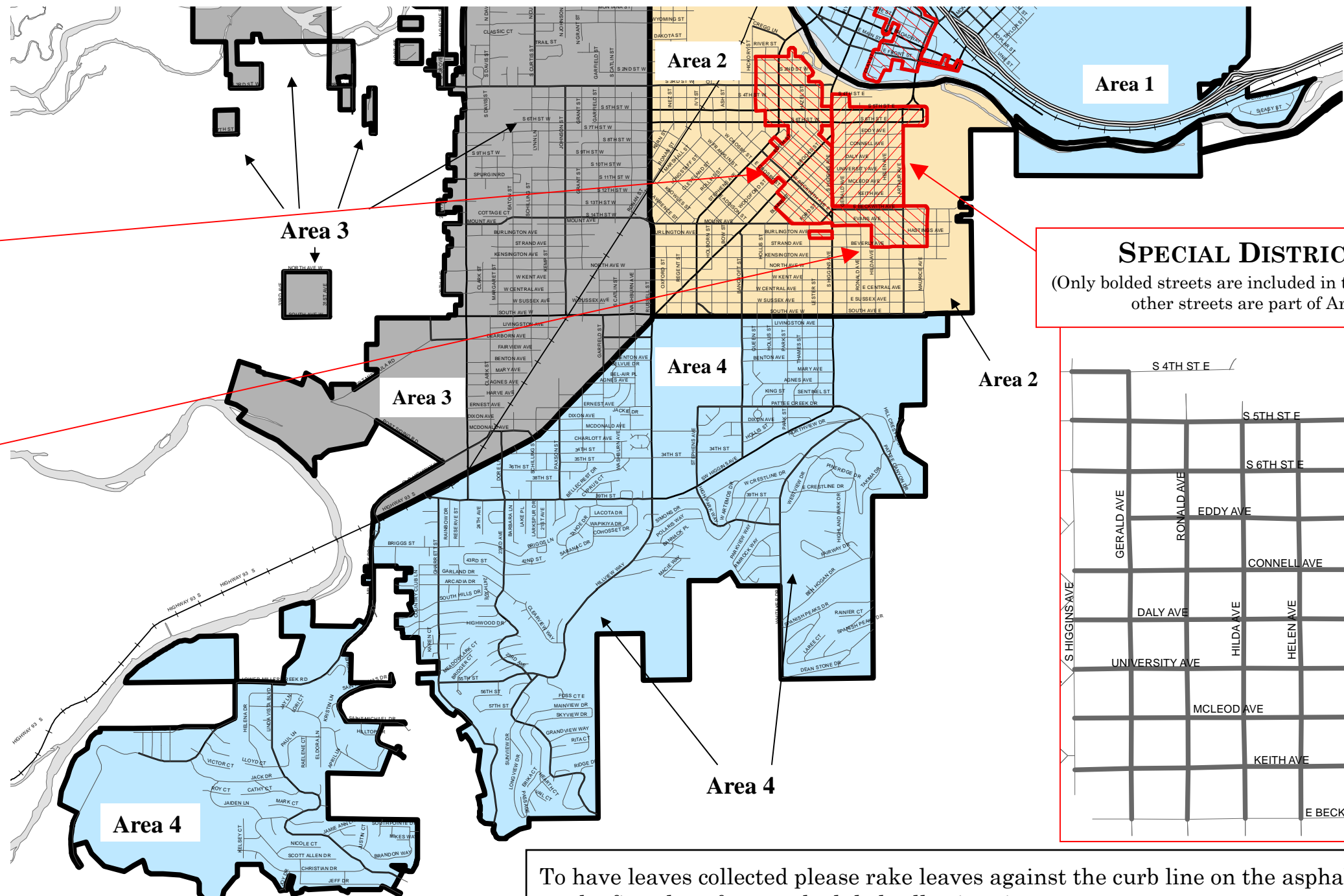
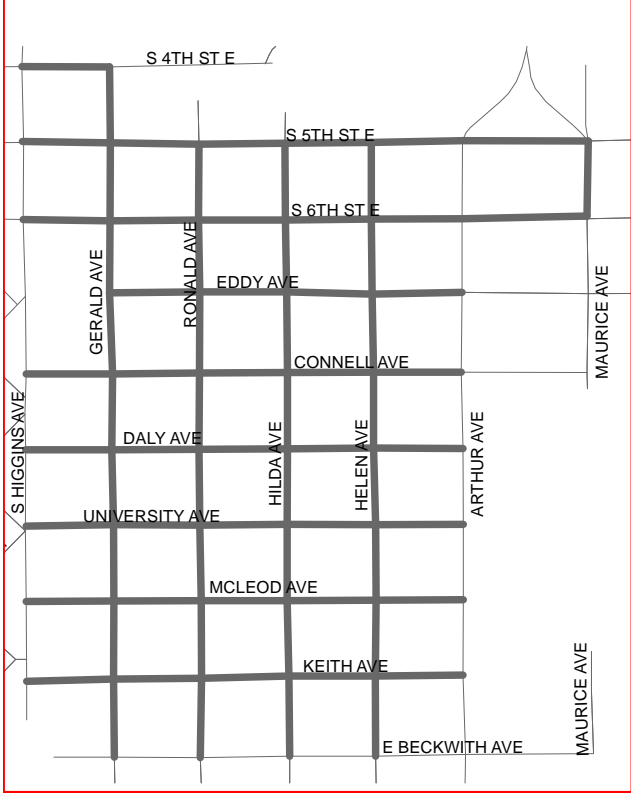


**SPECIAL DISTRICT #3**

 The other streets are part of Area 2.)



**SPECIAL DISTRICT #2**  
 (Only bolded streets are included in the district. The  
 other streets are part of Area 1.)



The Street Division uses a loader and trucks to pick up piles of leaves on **BOTH sides of the street**. Please try not to park around leaf piles. After the piles are picked up, the streets will then be swept using the parking schedule below.

**SWEEPING PARKING RESTRICTIONS**

**Even-numbered Days:** Park on the even numbered side of the street from 7:00a.m. until 5:00 p.m.

**Odd-Numbered Days:** Park on the odd-numbered side of the street from 7:00a.m. until 5:00 p.m.

**Special Sweeping Districts:** Districts are posted. Parking is prohibited on **BOTH** sides of the street from 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Vehicles will be towed to the nearest parking space, usually within a block of the vehicle's original location.

To have leaves collected please rake leaves against the curb line on the asphalt **PRIOR** to the first day of your scheduled collection time.

**Please make leaf piles long and skinny so they don't encroach into bike lanes or driving lanes.**

Debris, limbs, trash and other yard waste delay leaf collection efforts and will **not** be picked up. **Just leaves, please!**

Trees must be pruned to a minimum of 14 feet over street to the inside edge of the curb line, per MMC 12.32. If your trees do not meet this requirement they may be trimmed by the city in order to complete the leaf collection program.

What does the City do with the leaves it collects? The leaves are taken to Eko-Compost and used in the composting process to be returned to the environment. This program is one of the City's ongoing efforts for solid waste reduction, reuse, and recycling.
