for a Livable Tomorrow (MELT) will host a series of presentations conducted by fire scientist Jack Cohen, who spent his career finding strategies to help homes survive wildfires.

Cohen walks his audiences through how homes are destroyed during extreme wildfires, typically without burning the surrounding vegetation. He explains how this pattern of destruction points to opportunities for readily reducing home ignitability and preventing Wildland-Urban Interface fire disasters. He also addresses how homeowners can better prepare for wildfires.
