

STAGE 1: PROJECT/DEVELOPMENT INITIATION SUMMARY

This stage identifies the scope, concept, relevant planning documents, policies, and regulations supporting the proposed project.

There is no Stage 1 checklist. This stage includes the request for an Intent to Serve letter from the City for projects requesting connection to City water and/or sewer system(s).

Projects outside the city limits requesting connection to City water and/or sewer system(s) are required to gain approval from the Utility Service Review Committee (USRC) prior to requesting an Intent to Serve letter. Before a project or development can be heard by the Utility Service Review Committee, the land must be zoned.

By writing an Intent to Serve Letter, the City is agreeing to supply water to and/or accept sanitary sewerage waste from the proposed development. The Intent to Serve Letter satisfies subdivision application requirements. The developer is obligated to design and construct infrastructure necessary to serve the development, and the City will review and approve design prior to construction. The project may need to extend system mains and/or construct other system improvements in order for the system(s) to be “available” or ready for use. Therefore, “availability” of system(s) will be determined at Stage 3 once improvement plans (including design reports) are submitted for City review.
