Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:

Replace the 1996 Ford vehicle with newer vehicle to use during critical incidents. The current vehicle is unsafe to use in cold weather due to having to leave the engine running and the various exhaust leaks. Additionally, the vehicle does not start in colder weather.

History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed

The current CNT vehicle is a 1996 Ford Ambulance donated to the PD by MESI in 2005. At that time the vehicle was already nine years old. The PD CNT has used it for the past 18 years. It has had numerous issues, including a rebuilt engine installed years ago. Currently there are numerous exhaust leaks that render it unsafe for the Negotiators to use in cold weather when they need to keep the engine running. Often during the winter months, it won't start when needed making it undependable during crisis incidents. The 7.3L Powerstroke diesel is expensive to maintain and run.

We looked at Mercedes, Ford and Dodge vans for replacement. The most economical is the Dodge Ram. The purchase of a 2023 Dodge Ram 2500 with a 3.6L engine would enable the CNT a reliable vehicle for the next 15-20 years.
