Missoula Forest School

Great for homeschool families!

Level 1 is a once-a-week experience for ages 5-10 that immerses kids in nature, where they can observe and learn about the natural world, play nature awareness games, enjoy the outdoors in all weather, and have space and time for imaginative play and free exploration.

The program helps kids form bonds with each other and with nature, while fostering independence, curiosity, empathy, creativity, and thoughtfulness.

Level 2, known as Stone Age Survival, introduces kids to essential survival skills such as tracking, hunting, gathering, and creating deep connections with nature. Students learn principles that are applicable both in wilderness settings and in their daily lives.

Depending on the season and the group's interests, the program covers various survival and awareness skills including building shelters, starting fires, using atlatls, handling bows and arrows, knife work, naturalist studies, and improving dexterity, all while ensuring a fun and enriching experience.
