1. Welcome- Carol Ulrigg
2. Approval of Minutes- Minutes not submitted
3. Discuss Letters referring to relocation of traffic signal to Agnes and Brooks – Bob Martin/Peter Walker-Keleher, DJ&A- Actually here to talk about the Mary portion of the mall improvement, not Agnes. Project could start as soon as they have a plan. Commercial zone change is not a possibility at this time.
4. Fundraising for Bellevue Park Bike Skills Area- John O'Connor/Deke Tidwell- Tabled to July Meeting.
5. Bellevue Park Leafy Spurge- Bob said spurge has been sprayed with Tordon once. Discussed measures to mitigate mowing, pulling or spraying. Parks is working on the infestation.
6. Discuss Implementation of irrigation system- Decision to use Blades of Glory. Leadership team will get a copy of grant to them. Chris Boza said run the main line and laterals through the sleeves and then stop. Once the trees are planted the contractor can finish the drip lines to the trees.
7. Sandwich board sign funding- Bob Martin- Ended up with only 3 signs and made deal for 4<sup>th</sup> one. We do have some sign fronts that may be able to be revamped. Maybe some other options for piecing together a couple more signs by ordering from somewhere else.
8. Traffic Signal Box Grants- Oct 26 closing of grant process. Artists get \$1500/box. Russel/North and South/Garfield need to be painted. An Art Call must be made. Process- grant committee- then to community forum, then to city council. If we want a grant for our neighborhood, get it to Jane Kelly.
9. Public comment on Non-Agenda items- Bob Martin- Agnes Street time frame uncertain. Suggests the Neighborhood Council write a letter to ask for a time line for that project. Jane suggested she simply ask Doug Harby and/or MDT.
10. Office of neighborhood report- Jane Kelly- Corena coming back on Monday. Grants coming up. Sunday Streets July 17<sup>th</sup>. Stories and Stones—Date September 18<sup>th</sup>.
11. Treasurer's Report- No money!
12. Community Forum Report- Bob Martin- Missoula Economic Partnership Presentation, Goal to create 2500 jobs that pay \$37,000 or better. They have

achieved 2200. Presentation from Complete Streets. We should have a neighborhood transportation and sidewalk master plan.

13. Announcements- Neighborhood Trees Meeting Hosted by Missoula Parks and Rec on June 21 at City Life Center
