- 1. Approval of minutes of November 9, 2016**
 - a. October and November minutes approved.
- 2. Plan meeting with Parks and Rec: Work was stopped on the Bellevue Park irrigation project by Chris Boza because of an issue with the pump. Set up a meeting with all the parties to figure out how and when to move forward with this project—Chris Boza.**
 - a. Pump will be changed out to a variable frequency drive (VFD).
 - b. This can accommodate both drip and pop up pumps. That will allow drip system AND pop-up system for boulevard to be watered. Both 39th and Bellevue Park will be able to be watered. Trees will be planted in March/April by and contractor with water bags. The watering system will be up and running in May (ideally). Hans will contact contractor “Blades of Glory” to install sprinkler system. Trees will be planted by neighborhood council members. Tree species and numbers are identified in grant.
 - c. Chris mentioned they removed a Golden Willow and Black Cotton wood at the park because the trees began to die after the ditch (Pattee Creek) quit getting water.
- 3. Bike Skills Path at Bellevue Park - John O'Connor Friends of Missoula Parks (invited)**
 - a. Ian Foster – Friends of Missoula Parks: Involved in the bike community. Looking for someone to take the lead on fund raising for constructing the Park – construction will cost around \$30,000 for initial phase. Hans volunteered to meet with Ian’s organization to lay foundation.
 - b. Adjacent neighborhoods may be a good resource for additional funding. Reaching out to them and other donors (i.e. bike shops and interested kids) would be an important step.
 - c. Ian said he would be willing to knock on doors if someone contacts him with a contact – ifoster8@gmail.com or call 406-396-9562.

 - a. Will request two one for 34/35 junction and Paxon and 39th.
