1. Approved minutes of February 8, 2017

2. **Cowboy Flats Sub-Division – Dale McCormick:** Discussed the proposed site plan for a 32 lot subdivision adjacent to 38th street. Projected start date next spring. Neighborhood meeting about the project will be held in the Community Room on March 17th at 5:30 PM.
3. **Bellevue Park – Bike Skills Path – Kathy Jackson:** Still fund raising. Projected ground breaking sometime this summer funds pending. The Leadership Team agreed to request funding from the Cowboy Flats developers to augment the bike park funding.

4. Speed Limit issue at Russell School – Jon Wilkins
