1. Welcome and Introductions – Bob Hayes (City SWU Dept.), Jennifer Blick (Eco-Life Church)
2. Storm water utility (SWU) - Bob Hayes Superintendent: SWU just got established last year. They have a new facility and operations plan and later will have a rate plan, which is being determined by a consulting firm. Bob currently has one staff with plans to add 2 others after the rate study. There are over 9,000, 8' deep sumps in city and will clean each in a 5 year rotation. Can do 7-8 sumps per day using two 1,400 gallon shop- vac trucks. Also must administer over 30 miles of line and 4 levees.
3. Jennifer Blick – Community events sponsored by her church through the summer at Boyd Park (potential for SGT meeting/ice cream social at the same time). Events are July 29, August 5 and 19th – SGT meeting could occur Aug 5th or 19th?
4. Approval of the minutes of June 13, 2018 minutes - approved.
5. Treasurer's Report- No report, Hans not in attendance (new budget \$800, and mailing supplement \$702).
6. Bellevue Park – Bob and Mark
 - a. purchased four trees- burr oak, swamp oak, ginko, red maple
 - b. Old existing well – city water connection to water the park – it's painted and down six feet. Contact Chris Boza to do an analysis between using the well at the South End or using the old connection on 36th.
6. Boyd and McLeod Park. Need a Port-a-let for summer – Boyd Park is now pottied - not sure for McLeod.
7. MRL Park Update – Kelly Lloyd – Work is going full scale. Trail is paved and ready for use. Ribbon cutting July 18th at 9 am.
8. Cowboy Flats and 39th St. Updates – Bob Martin – Under full construction.

9. Moose Can Gully/South 39th St. meeting up-date – Bob, Mark - Chris Boza presented at the meeting, and the development of Hillview Park was another agenda item.

10. Community Forum Report: Mark – MUD presenter showed how one could use recycled glass to build a walking path – Mark thought it could be very expensive.

11. CSR follow-up and new CSR – Skip will get online and file for Washburn and Bel-Air Place storm drain cleanout.
