- 2. Housing Policy & CDBG funds** - Eran P, Grants Administrator Newly adopted housing policy. Adopted a Place to Call Home about a month ago. About 20 new programs and policies. Amending our city wide code and creating some stakeholder working groups. Adequate representation among all sectors/demographics of our community. Town-home exemption amendment in the works as well. Presenting to city council soon about accomplishments for the next year. Applications are available for people with limited incomes.
- 3. Storm Water** - Bob Hayes, Storm Water Superintendent October 2016 - Storm Water was formed. 1. Keep you safe and dry from storm water. 2. Meet or exceed storm water discharge requirements. Most storm water goes to recharge the aquaphor. About 9000 sumps in Missoula. 50 miles of pipes. Pet waste is one of the biggest contaminants for our water. Pick up your pet waste please. Others include yard waste, car wash waste etc. City Council will be giving a permanent rate vs. an interim rate. Will still be the smallest rate in the state. Will take affect sometime around Jan 1st. Storm water bill will be included with your water bill every month. Somewhere around \$3-4.
- 4. 9th Street proposed zoning** - Dale McCormick, Professional Consultants Inc. RM1-35 zoning change. SkyView Senior Living project. For people with limited income.
