2. Bellevue, Boyd and McLeod park needs were discussed including concerns about safety at the Bellevue Park bike course and two new signs in Bellevue Park. Is there a Phase II for Bellevue Park planned?
3. Boyd Park portalet: Would like to extend the duration of the portalet to cover from Memorial Day to Labor day. Discussed the possibility of a large grant or partnering with other agencies for a permanent bathroom at Boyd Park.

7. Election of Leadership Team Members: Larry Cron, Hans Christiansen, Mark Foss and Kelly Lloyd were all up for re-election and were re-elected. Mary Sajna was elected as Alternate for Community Forum Representative.
