-Birding area – Colleen Biehl is keeping in contact with Molly Dillingham, Park/Rec Dept. Gardener. Biehl's have watered twice and have left buckets in the encloser near the Stephen's Street gate. Conner's and Westfall's will meet on July 17 at 9am to go over procedures and set up a "schedule". With the recent rains all looks good and there are few weeds.

-Interpretive Sign Project and Trail work – No update on this approved project. Morgan Valliant is on vacation and Colleen will send an email to him next week to see if there is a schedule to begin the project, in particular the design aspect as we are to have input.

-Outdoor Classroom -John Conner met with Nathan Colin, Park/Rec Landscape Architect today. They meet in the park and check out the proposed area. Nathan is very enthusiastic about the "classroom". He felt the information provided by John through the grant proposal and our design is great. He will make the area ADA accessible and there will be a few adjustments in making the area as comfortable, low maintenance and "as natural" as possible.
