

## **Captain John Mullan Neighborhood Council Leadership Team Minutes**

1. Introductions and Roll Call
2. Approve minutes for April 26, 2021. Approved as posted, Antony moved and Janie Cook seconded. John Hancock announced that he has withdrawn from the Leadership Team.
3. Tom Zavitz of the Missoula Long Range City Planning Committee discussed the Captain John Mullan name change.  
The name: Sxw-tp-Qyen, in Salish, is the name being considered as it describes the riparian area near the Clark Fork River. Pronunciation was given as: (Swi tup cane) in 3 syllable segments. Consideration is ongoing by our City Council members and the Missoula City Council. Mirtha Becerra was unable to attend.
4. Heron's Landing- Dave DeGrandpre and Kevin Slovarp was unavailable. Colin Woodrow provided a viewing of the Engage Missoula website to find more information on the status of the project and plans. Colin Woodrow mentioned that a small number of plots in Heron's Landing will be available in late August and the balance before the end of the year.
5. George Elmer/Cattle Dr. roundabout - Ben Weiss was not in attendance. Colin gave a summary of the expense of traffic circles cost ranging from \$10,000 - \$20,000. There are several options of traffic calming devices being used around the city at a lower cost. Some options include: Plastic pylons, tree planting, free libraries, art designs, etc. John Hancock, who is dropping off the CJM Leadership Team, brought up the fact that he had learned that the round-about at George Elmer/Cattle Dr. would be pushed to 2022.
6. Neighborhood Improvement: Colin discussed that funds are available from the City for CJM neighborhoods improvement but must be submitted by late June. Antony moved to appropriate the money for an October forum. Since there was not a quorum, a vote will be taken by email.

7. Trash Bins and Mutt Mitts at NW and SW end of 44 Ranch Park - Lincoln Lake was not present. Colin added that in Lincoln's response that volume does not require trash receptacles to be added to the West side of 44 Ranch Park at this time. Some Missoula City parks require removal of trash 2X daily.
