- 2. Parks Update:** PJ gave update. We have applied for and received a \$5300 Neighborhood Improvement grant for the initial civil engineering work for Ninkpata. Whitaker has a new natural play area. There is a parks master plan for Ninkpata and Whitaker, but it hasn't been funded yet. Discussion of funding options.
- 3. Speeding Issues:** Drive Like Your Kids Live Here signs are available for people to take. There was some public comment on the observed speeding instances, including on Rimel Road. Evan is still working with Ben Weiss at the City to get portable speed limit warning signs out. There was a petition circulated for adding two stop signs on Whitaker. There was discussion about the City wanting to put speed tables on Simons. There was discussion about someone privately purchasing a portable speed limit warning sign, but that would require the City allowing it to be placed on the road.
- 4. Office of Neighborhoods:** Kalina gave an overview of the Neighborhood Councils. Leadership Team members made brief comments. Elections were held. Current Leadership Team members were all re-elected and two new members were added. Neighborhood priorities were discussed. The deer problem was brought up but the City has no intention of addressing it any time soon.
- 5. Comments from Mike Nugent:** Mike Nugent, one of Ward 4's City Council members, gave remarks and took questions from the public. He recommended people check out engagemissoula.com for upcoming City projects and general information.
