School Levy—Tyler Christensen discussed the elementary and high school levies that will be on May 2, ballot. These levies provide funds that are needed to run the public schools in addition to the per-pupil funding provided by the state general fund. Three school board members running for reelection are unopposed at this time. Ballots will be placed in the mail during the middle of April.

Minutes of the November 3, 2022 Leadership Team Meeting—Craig Van Bockel moved approval of the minutes. Kevin Davis seconded the motion. The motion passed by voice acclamation.

April 29, 2023 Neighborhood Cleanup Sponsored by the Office of Neighborhoods—Kevin Davis will see whether Montana Snowbowl has an interest in having a dumpster available for cleanup of the dirt parking lot north of Town Pump during neighborhoods cleanup April 29.

Grant Creek Village Development/Pedestrian Crossings at Expo Parkway and Stonebridge—Bert Lindler said that Grant Creek Village, which now has 187 units, had applied for a permit for another 40 units in a new building. The City is not acting on that permit until issues with the traffic impact study have been remedied. Once permits for 193 units have been approved, the development agreement requires the developer to provide pedestrian crossings at Expo Parkway and Stonebridge Road.

New Water Tank—The City water department has installed a second water tank alongside the existing tank at the top of Pinnacle Place in the Prospect Meadows subdivision. The new water tank was required to meet new building codes that require more water for firefighting in the lower end of Grant Creek above I-90. The tank is being completed now and should be put into service this spring or early summer.

General Meeting of the Grant Creek Neighborhood Council May 16—Kevin moved that the Grant Creek Neighborhood Council hold a **general meeting at 7 p.m. May 16**

at the Best Western Plus Grant Creek Inn with a hybrid virtual option for those who can't attend in person, if possible. Craig Van Bockel seconded the motion, which passed by voice acclamation. Seamus Land, who has studied Grant Creek and interviewed its residents for the past couple of years, will lead the audience in "Re-Storying Grant Creek."
