

Lower Rattlesnake Neighborhood Leadership Team Minutes

2. We approved the October 6, 2023 Minutes of the LRLT meeting, with the notation that the final item about having a meeting on November 8, 2023 should be removed from the minutes.
3. We approved the agenda for today's meeting, November 16, 2023.
4. We agreed that Gracie Sanford (and others) should go forward with a Grant Application by November 22, 2023 to provide a bench/picnic table at the entrance to the Mount Jumbo Trail.
