2. Approval of the minutes for October 12, 2023. Kathie Snodgrass moved to approve the October minutes, Janie Cook seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
3. Items to be discussed:
 - a. Missoula Aging Services
 - i. Clean-up Crew program to help older folks with yardwork they cannot do alone.

 - b. Identifying problem intersections
 - i. Update from Ben Weiss via Kalina Pritchard: Not much that can be done on George Elmer, England, and Mary Jane as they are priority fire access streets.
 - ii. Suggestions: Street painting that does not interfere with traffic flow, painting crosswalks, "Drive like your kids live here signs."
 - iii. England and George Elmer are issues. Mary Jane has slowed down, but the four-way stop-sign intersection with England is an issue. Perhaps painting the cross-walk at George Elmer and Cattle Dr.
 - iv. Priorities: George Elmer and Cattle, Mary Jane and England.
 - v. Next steps: Talk with Ben Weiss, identify specific tactical urbanism tactics to implement, find community artists, receive neighborhood feedback, apply for neighborhood grant.
