- Minutes from February in-person and virtual meetings approved
- Clint provided a presentation of a PowerPoint he created for the General Meeting to introduce the Leadership Team and review survey findings
- Map for door hanger routes was reviewed. Jenn will assist with dividing hangers into packets with maps and coupons from Bolt and Bruizers Bakery for volunteers to pick up starting March 11.
- General meeting schedule was discussed. Will plan for introductions, presentation from Clint as noted above, presentation from Neighborways, City Council Q&A, elections if any new volunteers, and raffle.
- Raffle prizes will consist of #4 \$50 gift cards from Yokes. The remaining \$79.33 of the Leadership Team's gift cards will be used by Jenn to purchase beverages for the General Meeting.
- Clint presented the flyer for the General Meeting which will be distributed to students at Franklin School prior to Spring Break (Kalina is in contact with the PTA), placed on sandwich boards throughout the neighborhood, and will be displayed in Mountain Line buses hopefully beginning this week.
- Clint will reach out to the Catholic church to discuss retrieving the sandwich boards, he and Will will attach flyers. Storage of the sandwich boards when not in use will be an ongoing question.
- Budget report- remaining budget after door hangers is \$2051.30
- Neighborhoods report: Leadership Team reports to City Council will begin this month and will be on a rotating 8-week schedule. Franklin to Fort will present March 25th, June 3rd, August 12th, and October 28th. Presentations will be ~3 minutes long and will consist of information regarding the Neighborhood previously approved by the Leadership Team. Jenn will present at the March meeting.
- Kalina and Clint along with 2 members of Neighbors in Action (NIA) met with Parks and Rec. to start the process of obtaining the proper permits for the September Block Party. Will continue with updates as this progresses.
