

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, ovarian cancer is the fifth leading cause of cancer deaths of women in the United States and causes more deaths than any other gynecologic cancer; and

WHEREAS, the five-year survival rate for ovarian cancer varies greatly depending on the stage of diagnosis; and

WHEREAS, the lack of an early detection test for ovarian cancer combined with its vague symptoms mean that approximately 80 percent of cases of ovarian cancer are detected at an advanced stage; and

WHEREAS, improved awareness of the symptoms and genetic risks of ovarian cancer by the public and health care providers can lead to a quicker diagnosis; and

WHEREAS, each year during the month of September, Ovarian Cancer Research Alliance (OCRA) and community partner organizations, hold a number of events to increase public awareness of ovarian cancer and its symptoms.
