WHEREAS, substance use disorder is a chronic health issue, not unlike other chronic health issues such as diabetes and cancer; and

WHEREAS, approximately 13,000 Missoula residents have struggled or are struggling with substance use, and nearly 10,000 of those have sought or are engaged in recovery support; and

WHEREAS, recovery from substance use and/or mental health is not only possible, it is an essential part of overall health and wellness; and

WHEREAS, stigma and stereotypes surrounding substance use disorder often deter people from seeking treatment; and

WHEREAS, public education, awareness and open discussion can promote recovery from substance use disorders and more effective treatments of substance use disorders.
