### 3. Public Comment

the following topics were talked about during public comment: bears in the rattlesnake in general, fast drivers being a hazard to bears, dark skies being important to the neighborhood, the city website being a resource to report hazards in the street, bike lanes, sidewalks and trails

### 4. Approve minutes from June 11, 2024 (approved at later date)

### 5. Update and action on transportation safety for Lower Lincoln Hills Drive.

-the committee continued to discuss hazards on Lower Lincoln Hills Drive, such as lack of safe walk and bikeways, parking on the shoulder, pedestrian crossing issues, and increasing traffic due to growth, the bike park and sports fields. The committee will continue to pressure local officials to make safety improvements.

### 6. Discussion and action on safety at Van Buren Roundabouts, with a focus on the lack of yielding at the blinking light for the eastbound I-90 on ramp.

-many in the group have experienced danger due to some drivers going too fast on some of the roundabout exits, including the eastbound on ramp onto I-90; short merges onto the interstate seem to cause some drivers to go too fast which degrades safety for everyone. The committee plans to write a letter to the City and the State to ask for safety improvements. This agenda item will be revisited in early 2025.

### 7. Needed parks and trails in the Rattlesnake Valley, to be advocated for in the City parks and trails master planning process.

-Bob agreed to send the Rattlesnake Transportation Plan to the planners involved in the PROST process.

### 8. Submitting the Rattlesnake Transportation Plan as part of the Growth Policy update and the Long Range Transportation Plan update.

-Bob agreed to submit the Rattlesnake Transportation Plan to the planners involved in both the growth policy update and the long range transportation plan update.
