- February Minutes approved with a minor amendment correcting today's meeting day to Tuesday

- Postcard design was approved. Voted to approve up to \$1560.00 for double sided printing on colored paper through the Missoula County Print Shop, and mailing through USPS. Clint will continue to work on this.
- Approved up to \$400.00 for 15 pizzas from Bridge Pizza, Jenn will arrange. Melissa will check to see if we have any funds left on the Yokes gift cards for drinks and desserts.
- Agenda for the General Meeting was discussed. Plan is to invite Climate Smart (Clint to do) and NIA (Jenny to do) to table. Jenn will reach out to MRA, and Clint will reach out to representatives from the Reserve Street Safety Action Plan to see if they would be available to table and give a brief introduction. Jenn will reach out to City Council and Mayor Davis to invite them, and to see if City Council members would be available for a Q&A. Clint will give a presentation on the Neighborhood Action Plan, and Will will give a presentation on the Neighborhood Energizer Grants. We also plan for elections. \$200 was approved to purchase four (4) \$50 gift cards from Rosauers to raffle off.
- Community Forum Report from Clint- PROST gave an update on feedback they have been receiving. They have a goal of residents of Missoula having a park or open space within a 10 minute walk of their homes, and the Franklin to Fort Neighborhood was highlighted as an area of opportunity for this. MRA gave an update on the Milwaukee Triangle project. On Our Way Home: Missoula Community Houselessness Strategy 2025-2028 will soon begin presentations to potential partners.
