Public Comment: Better snow plowing is needed, for safety and accessibility, in most of the neighborhood. There is danger at Broadway/Van Buren, especially with right turning drivers onto Broadway- this is a high walker/biker location and the committee is concerned that someone will get hit there.

Agenda:

a. Discussion on the upcoming code reform addressing density, parking, building heights, mixed use development, set backs, walkability, street standards and more:

-a general discussion was had about the future of growth in the Rattlesnake, and how we need to ensure a walkable and bikable neighborhood, with good transit, low rise density and mixed use development. We will monitor the Code reform by the City. Bob serves on the Citizen Advisory Committee for the growth and code projects and will keep the committee informed.

b. Discussion on neighborhood priorities for 2025: we discussed the following neighborhood needs:

- improved transit, both in frequency and coverage
- a trail from the wilderness area to the Clark Fork River path
- push for the Syringa Park proposal that emphasizes safety and access
- walk safety at the school
- our desires are reflected in the PROST project
