May minutes approval moved to July's meeting.

Cassie from Neighbors in Action introduced the plan for this year's gathering called "F2F Neighborhood Resilience Festival on August 27th 2025 from 5:30 to 8PM at Franklin Park. Instead of just a block party, it will focus on three themes: connection, food preparation, and emergency/disaster preparedness. It will be engaging for all ages and a fire truck is confirmed to be available.

Neighbors in Action is coordinating with guest organizations who are running the activities. Individual activities are yet to be confirmed.

Budget was discussed and Melissa will look into the feasibility of using neighborhood funds towards a NiA sticker.

F2F council voted and agreed to spend 861.90 for EDDM with USPS, 387.54 for printing postcards with Missoula County Print Shop, and 248 towards Poteet for road closure.

Melissa dispersed current and former bylaws for member review.

Carrie brought more information about the Bob Wards property and expressed concern the proposal for developers is not following the open space/greenspace that is described in the Midtown Master Plan. If interested please reach out to Carrie to learn more. The Leadership Team is in support of more opportunities for greenspace in and around F2F.

Jana Richter informed us Front Step is hosting outdoor cinema nights at Franklin Elementary School on Aug 15th and Sept 12th.

F2F Neighbors in Action is seeking volunteers to assist watering planters, specifically for folks who live near to Schilling and 13th.

Action items for next meeting:

- Set up and pay for EDDM, postcard printing, and Poteet road closure fee using 2024 funds before July 1st.
- Discuss other budget items including/possibly gift cards, ice cream, DJ fee, and stickers for Neighbors in Action.
