WHEREAS, drug overdoses have claimed the lives of more than 185 Missoula County residents since 2014, deeply affecting families, friends, and the entire community; and

WHEREAS, those impacted by overdose are our loved ones, each one deserving of dignity, compassion, and support; and

WHEREAS, proven harm reduction strategies such as naloxone access, fentanyl test strips, and recovery services are essential to saving lives and preventing future loss; and

WHEREAS, Missoula stands united in grief, resilience, and commitment to preventing overdose through education, connection, and community-driven action.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Andrea Davis, Mayor of the City of Missoula, in the State of Montana, hereby recognize the 31st day of August, 2025 as:
