3. Presentations:
 - a. Marie Nelson from Stormwater invited the leadership team to join a Pattee Creek Watershed Group that the city is helping to recruit people for but will not run. The Rattlesnake and Grant Creek both have watershed groups that help watch the water quality and maintain a healthy habitat and FVPC could benefit from a group.
 - b. There is a stormwater project happening at Takima Park starting on Sept 15th
 - i. This will build a tiered stormwater bioretention basin to prevent flooding and protect water quality.
 - ii. Benefits: The Facility will capture and filter runoff and reduce the amount of toxins and pesticides entering local waterways. By improving water quality, the project supports healthier fish habitat and enhances biodiversity. Native vegetation will be planted throughout the basin, providing valuable habitat for pollinators and wildlife.

 1. Possible NAP ideas: Provide Education to neighbors on traffic projects in the area and ways traffic mitigation can be used, Requesting a Speed Study on certain roads.

 1. Possible NAP ideas: Provide education to neighbors and continue to push for movement on within the city.
 - iii. Parks and Trails



1. Possible NAP ideas: Evaluate ways Nikpata could be utilized and upgraded outside of the Masterplan, advocate for the Broken building at Whittaker Park to be taken out or repurposed, and marking trails and easements for ease of access for the public.
