Public Comment on items not on the agenda

Mr. Purcell introduced himself as a candidate for sheriff.

The public wanted to comment on the increased traffic with the Miller creek diversion. Many are complaining about speeding through the neighborhood streets. They were urged to notify either city council members or local law enforcement about problem areas.

Survey the neighborhood for views for or against a hands free cellular use in automobiles

A simple vote indicated the majority are in favor of a hands free cellular use law within the city limits.

Update on the Tonkin Trail progress

Jeff Stevens said there is the possibility of applying for grant money for a mutt mit station and refuse can at one end of the trail head. The public was asked to comment and a vote was approved to proceed with trying to secure some grant funding. Stone benches were also discussed and another idea was to seek donations from locally owned businesses.

Neighborhood Large Project Grant Funds

Should the neighborhood apply for a grant for traffic signal box art work done by local artists on the boxes in the area. All were in favor of pursuing grant money for this.

Garden City Harvest, Genevieve Jessop-Marsh

Representative from Garden City Harvest spoke about adding a neighborhood garden. Many are in favor of this. We will try to find possible locations for a second neighborhood garden.
