- Direct OPG Staff to draft an amendment revising the accessory dwelling unit (ADU) provisions of Title 20 with the following provisions and to refer the amendment to the Planning Board for review: Revise Chapter 20.45 Missoula Municipal Code entitled, "Accessory Uses and Structures" to allow ADUs by right in all zoning districts that allow residential uses where one of the dwelling units is owner-occupied; revise Chapter 20.60 Missoula Municipal Code to reduce required parking to one parking space for a second primary dwelling unit on a parcel that contains no more than two dwelling units, totaling three required parking spaces for the two units. This would apply to two single detached units or a two-unit house. OPG staff is directed to draft these changes as text amendments to Title 20 and to include a finding of fact and conclusion of law in the staff report indicating the amendments are text amendments.
