1. Report on Russell St. - Loran Frazier
  - a. First phase was discussed: 2<sup>nd</sup> Street to Idaho Street
  - b. Second phase was discussed: Idaho Street to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street
    - i. They are still working on them.
  - c. WGM plans to save West Broadway for now.
  - d. It was mentioned to get in touch with Missoula in Motion - they have 3,000 people who want updates about traffic control plans and they would love to hear about Russell Street and possibly get on their email list.
2. Waverly to Stoddard Bike Route Improvement - Ben Weiss
  - a. Graffiti and Garbage on a public school walking path
  - b. There is a triangle piece of land owned by some lady and she might allow in the future allowing a trail through there to that undercrossing.
  - c. Another citizen has requested that two stop signs on a bike route don't make sense. Everyone agrees that this was a bad idea, but when they went out to go knock on some doors and get neighborhood support, they only got one answer.
    - i. How do we let those neighborhoods weigh in and have some input?
    - ii. Input is needed on Waverly and Cooley. Decided that they will have a mailing in advance with this meeting and elections for the Northside/Westside Leadership Team.
3. Project for WS Softball Team to Work on: Stoddard under the Scott St. Bridge - Ben Weiss
  - a. Service project to help improve the Stoddard Bike Route improvement. Ben Weiss was thinking that there could be a service project to the winner of the softball game from the loser and he was thinking that they could work to improve the bike path.
  - b. Project for Westsiders to clean up that area.
    - i. Including but not limited to: Major Sweeping, graffiti cover up or something like a sanctioned mural, major pruning, and widening that sidewalk.
