Community Art Park Workshop

Missoula, MT / April 8, 2014, / Missoula Art Museum (MAM) / MAM is pleased to announce a Community Art Park Workshop for Missoula's new park. Everyone is invited to come to the Missoula Art Museum to help envision the community's use of the City's urban sculpture park at MAM and Adventure Cycling. Donna Gaukler, Missoula Parks and Recreation Director, will facilitate this community discussion and Laura Millin, Missoula Art Museum Executive Director, along with SPPV Landscape Architects, will introduce the project.

Laura Millin talks about the project, "MAM envisions using the plaza-like space for outdoor display of permanent and temporary sculptural artworks, as an outdoor classroom and gathering space in the summer months, and welcomes other downtown non-profit organizations to consider similar uses. The park plaza landscape will feature trees, seating, and public facilities to encourage visitors to relax amidst the installation of art, and it will extend across the street to Adventure Cycling's site. The park is being developed in collaboration with the City of Missoula."
