1. Bert Lindler reported on the Grant Creek Trail grant acquisition process and of the recording of trail easement process. Emily gave an update on the status of the speed study. State Commission permanently signed the 35 MPH limit. The route is a State Urban Route. The trail extension study was to start at Lincoln Wood and end at Tamarack.

2. Urban deer interface with humans was reported on by Bill Ruediger. Control measures included vaccinations and efforts to reduce deer population. There were no good measures available.
