1. NSWS Block Party Preparation

- Block party is July 19 from 3pm to 9pm
- Kali will pick up cups, table, chairs, canopy, signage from Office of Neighborhoods on July 18
- Kali will setup at event and Terri will assist
- Terri will table from 3 to 5
- We will have large maps made with assistance of Office of Neighborhoods (Terri will discuss with Shelby and Jane)
- We will have information including Letters of Support from city related to the White Pine Sash issue
- There will be a sign-up for City Digest (make sure with have a talking points related to describing the City Digest)
- We will potentially have popsicles and lemonade, Kali has coolers and Shelby will check into a container for lemonade

2. Budget Report

- It was determined that we did not have a quorum at meeting and that we could spend \$100 increments of budget
- NS General Budget = \$131.56; NS Mailing Supplement Budget = \$5.39
- WS General Budget = \$630.11; WS Mailing Supplement Budget = \$(.01)
- Expenditures approved to be spent from current budget before June 30 are:

- a. Motion to approve up to \$100 for Turner Street property clean up by Kali and 2nd by Christian, approved by LT (end of Turner next to L'il Bear Mini Storage and North West of Missoula Food Co -op).** Terri will purchase supplies to be reimbursed and purchases will come from West side budget.
- b. Motion to approve up to \$100 for Scott Street Bridge cleanup by Terri and 2nd by Kali, approved by LT** - (under bridge on North end). Ann will purchase supplies and be reimbursed and purchases will come from Northside budget.

3. New Business

- Future help with funding free community dinners held at 1500 Burns Street every three months. Next dinner will be in September. Funding will help in the purchase of food for the dinners.

-Future funding of family activities at the NSWS Softball game where LT will table and provide information related to our leadership team

4. Public comment on non agenda items

-Discussion of writing a Letter of Support to North Missoula Community Development Corporation for retaining an attorney to represent residents in White Pine Sash to encourage Department of Environmental Quality to decide on full residential cleanup of the area

-Christian discussed that he has been approached by west-side neighborhood residents to pursue stop signs at intersection of Cooley Street and Burns Street and intersection Stoddard Street and Burns Street, Shelby said she would look into this

-Kali mentioned that north-side residents have been noticing a natural gas smell near the railroad tracks and that N/S Council Rep, Bryan von Lossberg is looking into this. Residents have been encouraged to contact City Health Department.
