1. Jane Kelly, Neighborhood Coordinator, Jesse Neidigh, Melissa Neidigh, Prairie Wolfe, Joyce Sheppard, Kim Walterskirchen, Patrick Guinard and Loran Frazier were in attendance.
2. Loran Frazier of the WGM Group gave a presentation on the Milwaukee Trail Crossing Options of Russell Street. The Russell Street project will begin in 2016 and they are currently meeting with various committees to gather input for the final design. Three different designs were shown: Box style, archway and open designed bridge. The archway design was favored.
3. Jesse Neidigh gave the Community Forum updates. The Missoula Growth Policy resources are compiling a list of the communities to select “favorite things” about our Missoula area. The public is encouraged to send in pictures to www.OurMissoula.Org to participate. The area schools have implemented a I-3, a new concept idea where the student decides what they want to learn and by what method. This is a trial program.

The next steps on the neighborhood plan are to continue with monthly meetings and continue to work on sidewalks, keeping in mind the original infrastructure ideas, the ideals of the various homeowners and businesses and dealing with light industrial along with areas that are known for tree lined roads.
