The meeting was called to order by Anne Nelson at 7:22PM.

1. In attendance:

2. A vote was taken and Antony Jo and Patrick Claytor were included as interim leadership team members. Their membership will be voted on at the General Meeting. Their vote will count at LT meetings and we have a quorum for this evening.
3. The minutes of the March 4 meeting were approved
4. The agenda was approved
5. The first discussion was about traffic calming on England Blvd. Robin presented pictures of traffic calming examples. b.) Wildlife Management group made a presentation about urban wildlife areas. They are hoping to help Missoula become the first county in Montana to become recognized as an Urban Wildlife Habitat

They will also be at Bonner Park May 12. The parks dept. will be there offering traffic circle training, pruning, plant choices, etc.

The focus being on helping the community to better organize into special interest groups such as gardening, day care, stay at home moms, etc. It would also help them to better attend/participate in the CJM Neighborhood Council meetings.
