H. PUBLIC HEARINGS

- **Annexation, Zoning, Rezoning and Subdivision –Chickasaw Place**

Public hearing on a [resolution](#) to annex and zone property known as Chickasaw Place located along South Seventh Street West, approximately 1/4 miles west of Tower Street. The property is currently zoned C-RR1 (Residential) in the County and upon annexation, is proposed to be zoned RLD-2 (Residential, 2 du/acre) in the City. The City Council will consider an [ordinance](#) rezoning the property from RLD-2 (Residential, 2 du/acre) to RLD-4 (Residential, 4 du/acre). The City Council will also consider a proposed 9.36 acre subdivision creating 30 single dwelling lots, for a residential density of 3.2 dwelling units per acre. The property is legally described as Lots 53 & 54 of Dinsmore's Orchard Homes Addition No. 5, located in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 24 of T13N, R19W, P.M.M. ([PAZ](#)) ([memo](#)) ([Annexation Report & Development Agreement](#)) **This item was returned to the Plat, Annexation and Zoning Committee.**
