

Rose Park Neighborhood Council – Leadership Team Meeting Minutes

December 16, 2020 (Wednesday) – 5:00 pm – via Zoom (Office of Neighborhoods)

Chair Casey Erickson called meeting to order. Introductions and welcome.

Minutes of Sep.23.2020 Rose Park NC LT Meeting via ZOOM – Approved.

Traffic Safety Concerns – Tate reported on what he thought was a significant increase in traffic speeds and careless driving. Discussion about inviting PD representative to attend an LT meeting to report on PD efforts toward enforcement.

Rose Park Portalet Enclosure – Painter reported that some initial work had started at Rose Park.

Community Forum Report - Tony participated in two community meetings -

- Long-Term Transportation Plan – Aaron Wilson, with Development Services, provided information on the plan and sought input from all interested neighborhoods.
