We've received inquiries from councilmembers about the possibility of a local 501c3 organization called Housing for Humans becoming the operational partner for ACS. Our team has spoken with one member of this effort but have received no additional information that would allow us to assess the viability of this proposal. I've also reached out to our community partners, including Jill Bonny with the Poverello Center. They are unaware of this effort and are also eager to learn more. She encouraged councilmembers to reach out to her prior to considering a partnership to better understand the complexities of providing shelter services 24/7, especially in light of the identified barriers at ACS.
