The Emergency Winter Shelter in the Johnson Street Community Center at 1919 North Ave. W. will close for the season on April 10.

Since it opened Oct. 31, the shelter has served an average of 116 people per night.

Missoula's lower-income housing landscape has improved since a year ago, with several new projects that will provide housing for moderate- to low-income residents leasing now.
