II. Comments from Police Staff

Assistant Chief Mike Brady gave a department update including the hiring of five new officers with four of them attending the Montana Law Enforcement Academy. They are scheduled to graduate December 11, 2009. One of the officers was POST certified and is currently in the department's FTO program.

A review of work comp injuries was done. In addition, there were two officers who have returned from military duty with another scheduled to return on December 1, 2009. One additional officer is expected to be activated for most of 2010.

The department's budget was discussed and the department is on track to meet the City's goal of reducing our FY'10 budget by 3.75% due to work comp savings and the delay involved in hiring of replacement officers resulting in some vacancy savings.

The SRO Officers for the middle schools have returned to the schools this month.

The Uniform Patrol Briefing room has been completed and this portion of Patrol operations has been moved.
