*(State law and City Council rules set guidelines for inviting community comment in a formal way on certain issues. Following a staff report on each item, the City Council and the Mayor invite community comment. The City Council normally votes on the same night as the public hearing unless one Council member requests that it be returned to a City Council committee for further consideration.)*
- Public hearing on a conditional use for the Good Shepherd's Preschool center to care for 13 or more children located at 2425 39<sup>th</sup> Street. The property is zoned RT10 (two unit/townhouse), and is legally described as the North 130 feet of Lot 1 in Peery Addition, located in Section 6 of Township 12 North, Range 19 West. ([Memo](#)) ([PAZ](#)) **Approved unanimously.**
  - Public hearing on a conditional use order to expand the existing Carmike Cinemas Theater located at 3620 Mullan Rd. by adding two large format screens, 800 additional seats, associated bicycle and vehicular parking, and pedestrian facilities. The property is currently zoned C1-4 Neighborhood Commercial, and is legally described as COS 3914

in Section 18 of Township, 13 North, Range 19 West P.M.M. ([Memo](#)) ([PAZ](#)) **Approved unanimously.**

- Public hearing on a [resolution](#) to levy a special assessment and tax upon all property situated within the pooled sidewalk curb, gutter and alley approach bonds series 2010 of the city of Missoula, Montana, in the total amount of \$885,000 excluding debt service to defray the cost of installing sidewalks, curbs, gutters and alley approaches pursuant to [resolution number 7539](#) awarding sale of bonds. ([Memo](#)) ([A&F](#)) **Approved unanimously.**
- Public hearing on a [resolution](#) levying assessments on property situated within Special Improvement District Number 544 (Rattlesnake Valley Sewer Project) of the City of Missoula, Montana, in the total amount of \$2,028,089.77 excluding debt service, to defray the cost of making the improvements in said special improvement district pursuant to [resolution number 7444](#) creating said district. ([Memo](#)) ([A&F](#)) **Approved amended resolutions 9 ayes, 2 nays with Haines and Mitchell voting nay.**
- Public hearing on a [resolution](#) levying assessments on property situated within Special Improvement District Number 545 (Phillips Street Traffic Calming Project) of the City of Missoula, Montana, in the total amount of \$19,999.71 excluding debt service, to defray the cost of making the improvements in said special improvement district pursuant to [resolution number 7435](#) creating said district.
