- The meeting was called to order by Mick Owens at 6:30p.
- Introductions and Welcome to Guests  
Each attendee introduced themselves to the group.
- Katie MacKendrick, Coordinator, Rattlesnake Creek Watershed Group, spoke to the group about her organization's mission and current goals, including noxious and toxic weed control, irrigation ditch issues, water conservation and quality, fish habitat, and organizational capabilities of the RCWG. Discussion ensued regarding how the RCWG and URNC may work together.
- Lolo Street Improvements: Emily Plant stated that, according to Councilman Dave Strohmaier, the improvements planned for Lolo Street will be postponed until next year.
- URNC 2011 General Meeting: The group discussed topics for inclusion on the agenda, including, but not limited to – Revisions to the URNC Bylaws; a presentation regarding wildlife in the Rattlesnake Valley, and a presentation by a Missoula Police Department representative regarding crime prevention.
- Rattlesnake Valley Transportation Summit Study: Mick Owens will contact Doug Harby, Construction Project Manager, Public Works Department, regarding the status of Rattlesnake School funding of a sidewalk project on Lincoln Hills Drive.
- Speed Limit on Upper Rattlesnake Drive: No news to date; no updates from the City of Missoula.
- URNC Bylaws Revisions: It was recommended that the term "County Representative" be changed to "County Liaison", to better define this position as a resident in the URNC Leadership Team instead of a Missoula County resident.
