1. Report on the Bus Master Plan—Bill Pfeifer, Mountain Line
 - a. *Bill discussed changes that will occur to improve ML service over the next 3 years. He described tiered system which determines renovations to bus stops. F2F has two tier 1 routes (stops slated for improved signage, seating, and cover) and has seen increased ridership since zero-fare began.*
2. Discussion of July general meeting
 - a. *Brad reviewed supplies purchased and budget of general meeting.*
 - b. *Matt solicited comment on quality of event and estimated that 75-80 community members were in attendance.*
3. Grant Ideas (*LT members researching grant ideas and will discuss which or how to pursue at next LT meeting*)
 - a. Traffic Signal Box Artwork
 - i. *Michelle Cares completing grant application to decorate 2-3 more traffic signal boxes; application due Oct. 6th.*
 - b. Mountain Line Stops
 - i. *Leadership Team intrigued by “adopt-a-stop” idea; Tim Streets will be reviewing master plan to evaluate impact on F2F neighborhood (re: unsigned bus stops and any cancelled stops).*
 - c. Possible mural on the outbuilding at Franklin Park
 - i. *Sarabeth will be contact Parks Dept and Arts Council to inquire about possibility of a mural at an outbuilding of Franklin Park*
 - d. Map of Greenways
 - i. *map determined too ambitious and duplication of Greenways project already being done in Missoula; possibility of Greenway signs at “Adopt-a-stop” bus stops was discussed*
