The Committee recommended to partially fund the following grants: Play it Missoula! Piano Project, the Art Park Water Fountain and the Improved Amenities for Bus Riders.

On the Play it Missoula! Piano Project: the committee recommends funding \$1,750.00 for Piano Paint for touch up and new piano and an Artist Commission for 1 Piano.

On the Art Park Water Fountain: the committee recommends funding \$2,000.00 of the \$3,000.00 requested.

On the Improved Amenities for Bus Riders: the committee recommends funding \$1,600.00 of the \$2,000.00 requested.

The Manufacturing Incubator was not recommended for funding.

Ray Aten made a motion to fund the grants as ranked. Mary LaPorte seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

unanimously.
